I have been looking back at the progress of the LS Challenge from its launch in February. We began after the appeal with the magnificent total of 2382 points. Then as the appeal was just in its infancy the Coronavirus struck, the Church was closed and our post box for our returns was shut down. As you can imagine this had a disastrous effect on the challenge not least because communications were drastically cut. Therefore the results for March were: 470, April were: 797 and May were: 938. If you think about it, it does show that despite our world being turned upside down the totals are Increasing, so I say to you all well done and keep up the good work and encourage anyone you know who may have lapsed to take up the challenge again. We are in this for 3 years so we have plenty of time to make up lost ground. Tony
