Letter from Rt Rev Patrick McKinney, Bishop of Nottingham 18.01.2021

Dear Parishioners of Sts Peter and Paul Parish,

I have asked Fr Matthew Jakes to move from St Hugh's, Lincoln to become Parish Priest of Holy Souls and St Bernadette's, Scunthorpe, St Norbert's, Crowle, and St Thomas of Canterbury, Gainsborough.

This has meant that I have asked Canon Edward to move to St Hugh's, Lincoln, as Parish Priest whilst also remaining Parish Priest here in St Peter and St Paul's. I have asked Canon Geoffrey Hunton to remain here, working with Canon Edward in providing pastoral care for you. I am grateful to them both. These moves will take effect in the week beginning 15 February.

I have also asked Canon Edward to work with the clergy and the Parish Pastoral Councils to begin the process of a closer working relationship across the three parishes of the City of Lincoln.

These are challenging times for us all in the diocese. You are all very much in my prayers, please keep me in yours.

A MESSAGE FROM THE ARBORETUM CAFÉ: My son Oliver is involved in the Abbey Access project running from the Arboretum on Monks Road Lincoln. They are providing cooked meals for children and families in need and acting as a food bank. They were on Look North (14th January on the 6.30pm slot) and the Lincolnite. If you know of any families who are struggling get them to contact him. No vouchers are needed!

..... Another busy day in the kitchen! We have cooked 160 meals ready for collection. We have cooked, boxed up and chilled down 2 meal types and we have a minimum of 5 different vegetables in each meal and have no salt or sugar added to the meals and have no additives in them. We have made a Chinese style chicken curry with lots of vegetables, obviously, and rice and a chunky vegetable chili with couscous and a wrap. We have had so much help and kind donations from people and local businesses that have made this possible. We are going to do some videos showing how to cook healthy meals at low cost which are full of nutrition, so if anyone knows any tips on making a video please let us know!
