COVID-19 PANDEMIC – RELAXATION OF RESTRICTIONS AN UPDATE:

The guidance issued by the Bishops' Conference of England following the move in to Step 3 indicates the following:

- A reassessment of seating capacity – hopefully, this weekend we will be able to increase the permitted people attending Sunday and Weekday Masses.
- Incense can be resumed.
- Congregational Singing – still prohibited, other than a Cantor.
- Readers are now permitted to read from the Lectionary, with minimum of touch.
- Prayers of the Faithful can now resume from the Lectern.
- Offertory Procession can now resume, with those involved sanitizing their hands beforehand.
- Sign of Peace remains suspended.
- Holy Communion under one kind. Communion is recommended to be received in the hand. However, should those who wish to receive on the tongue they should wait until the end of the Communion Line. **(NB. Communion on the tongue exposes the Priests' hand to your aerosol emissions and saliva and increases the possibility of viral infection – please do consider your Priest before requesting Communion on the tongue.)**
- Celebration of Baptism - 30 People
- Celebration of Marriage - 30 People
- Celebration of Funerals - dependent upon reassessed Church capacity
- Home visits can now take place by Priests, Deacons and Extra-Ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. It is recommended that one morning and one afternoon visit is made in any one day.
- Veneration of Statues: they can be touched, but not kissed.
- Holy Water Stoups to remain empty.
- Votive Candles available, but not tapers or lighters, please light from a lit candle.

G7 NEXT WEEKEND: Next weekend the G7 leaders will be meeting in Cornwall from **11th-13th June**. If you feel you could write to Mr. Johnston encouraging him to urge the leaders to be courageous and make sure that the developing countries have access to free Vaccines for Covid until all the world's population is protected for the sake of the poor and also to make sure the entire world is safe, for the producers to waver the patent rights for a brief period of time to enable the countries to develop the vaccine in their own nation. However, please pray for the weekend that all the leaders will be moved to act with wisdom, justice, mercy and integrity for all those in such desperate need of help to recover from the pandemic.
