MAINTENANCE OF PROPERTIES: Further works on the drains will be undertaken over two days on 7th and 8th July.

New noticeboards around the Church and Parish Centre, hopefully illuminated, thus advertising more our presence, have been ordered and are in production; they will be erected and put in place September 2021.

A Tree Surgeon will be attending to the trees around our properties on 6th July.

A new Fire Alarm Control Panel has been fitted for the Parish Centre and is now fully operational.

A quotation has been requested for the installation of external CCTV Cameras around the Church.

Designs are being prepared for an Aumbry on the Sanctuary for the Holy Oils and for Ledges either side of the Tabernacle to accommodate the Wellingore Chapel big six, also the handrails either side of the Tabernacle will be removed.

Another Sanctuary Lamp will be located nearer to the Tabernacle, the original will remain in situ as a sign of honour to the Holy Oils.

A Lamp Holder will be placed to the left of the Statue of Our Lady of Lincoln.

Votive Candle stands have now been placed beneath the Statues of St Peter and St Paul.
