MAINTENANCE OF PROPERTIES: A report and recommendations has been received and further works on the drains will be undertaken over the coming weeks.

Permission has been granted from the Diocese to proceed with an upgrade of the PA System in the Church; works will commence this coming Tuesday and will take three days. ***This means that on at least two of those days the current PA System will be out of action.***

TEAS AND COFFEES AFTER MASS: Whilst we are unable to celebrate our Feast Day, I am hopeful that soon we will be able to serve teas and coffees after our Sunday Masses. We will have to observe the current social distancing guidance and will need volunteers willing to sanitize the Parish Centre after each session.
