Mass Intentions: One of the great gifts we can give to someone is to have a Mass offered for their intention or for the repose of their soul. If you would like a specific date, please give us as much notice as you can (we are usually booking a month in advance, but at busy times it can sometimes be longer, for example the next available Mass in our Parish is in mid December) and we will try, as far as possible, to accommodate this. We always try to celebrate your Mass on the date you have requested, however a funeral will take precedence and a booked Mass on the date a funeral takes place will be rearranged to the nearest date possible thereafter. Unfortunately, we will not always be able to let you know of a change, but please be reassured your Mass will be said.
