If you would like a specific date, please give as much notice as you can (we are usually booking a month in advance, but at busy times it can be longer, for example the next available Mass in our Parish is late November) and we will try to accommodate this. We always try to celebrate your Mass on the date you requested, however a funeral will take precedence and a booked Mass on the date a funeral takes place will be rearranged to the nearest date possible thereafter. Unfortunately, we will not always be able to let you know of a change, but please be reassured your Mass will be said.
