WORLD DAY OF THE POOR - The sixth World Day of the Poor will be celebrated by the Catholic Church this Sunday, with the theme of "For your sakes Christ became poor" (2 Cor 8:9). Pope Francis, in his message for the upcoming day, said: "The World Day of the Poor comes this year as a healthy challenge, helping us to reflect on our style of life and on the many forms of poverty all around us." Highlighting the current challenges facing the world's poor, he added: "Several months ago, the world was emerging from the tempest of the pandemic... Now, however, a new catastrophe has appeared on the horizon [the war in Ukraine], destined to impose on our world a very different scenario." How can we help the poor in our personal lives?
