Second Collection for World Communications Day to be taken at all Masses this weekend. Each year, the Vatican and many dioceses mark World Communications Day on the Sunday before Pentecost. The Pope's choice for the theme is: "Speak with the heart: Veritatem facientes in caritate" (Speaking the truth in love).

240 Boultham Park Road & 2a Skellingthorpe Road Works on 2a are concluding. There are still several items to be completed which I am hoping will be attended to by the end of May. The most important of these is the metal gates. The telephone line to 2a is now fixed and the 01522 682278 land line restored. The Diocese will now make the decision as to when 240 BPR is marketed. The funds raised from the sale will go some way towards paying for the works undertaken at 2a. At the time of writing, I do not know the full cost of the reconfiguring and refurbishing of 2a, however, may I remind all that the sale of 240 BPR will not cover the works undertaken and there will be a significant shortfall which means the Parish will be in debt to the Diocese for the foreseeable future. I am now making the slow move from 240 BPR to 2a, this will take a couple of weeks or so, please bear with me and Tina during this time – thank you! Canon Geoffrey.
