The Diocese will decide as to when 240 BPR is marketed over the coming month or so. The funds raised from the sale will go some way towards paying for the works undertaken at 2a. At the time of writing, I do not know the full cost of the reconfiguring and refurbishing of 2a, however, may I remind all that the sale of 240 BPR will not cover the works undertaken and there will be a significant shortfall which means the Parish will be in debt to the Diocese for the foreseeable future. I am now making the slow move from 240 BPR to 2a, this will take two to three weeks or so, please bear with me and Tina during this time – thank you! Canon Geoffrey

Olive wood carvings from the Holy land (Bethlehem): We are the Good Shepherd Company, based in Nottingham. Our goal is to support and help the Christian families in the holy land to stay in work as olive wood carvers. It is one of the most important sources of income for them, as 90% of the Christians rely on this sale. Selling their produce here on their behalf, will prevent the Christians from leaving the country in search of better work opportunities, as a test survey from the bishops of Jerusalem there is only 41,000 Christians left in the area. We will be at SSPP on **17th and 18th June**.
