On the occasion of the Third World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly. already established on the fourth Sunday of the month of July with this year's theme "His mercy is from age to age" (Luke 1:50), graciously grants the Plenary Indulgence from the heavenly treasures of the Church, under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer according to the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff) to grandparents, elderly and to all the faithful who, motivated by the true spirit of penance and charity, will participate on 23 July 2023, on the occasion of the Third World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly. This also grants a Plenary Indulgence on this same day to the faithful who will dedicate adequate time to visit in person or virtually, through the means of communication, elderly brothers and sisters in need or in difficulty (such as the sick, the abandoned, the disabled). To obtain the Plenary Indulgence, given the detachment from any sin and the intention to fulfil the three customary conditions as soon as possible, the sick elderly and all those who, unable to leave their homes for a serious reason, will join spiritually in the functions sacred hearts of the World Day, offering to the Merciful God their prayers, the pains and sufferings of their lives, especially while the words of the Supreme Pontiff, and the various celebrations will be transmitted through the media. The Pope's message is published in full on the noticeboards.

WhatsApp: If you are involved in a parish WhatsApp group please read the Curia's published Police Advisory Notice to Churches on the noticeboards.

Sunday Morning Coffee Rota: The new coffee morning rota is up in the Lady Chapel. It is very empty!! This rota covers all Sundays up to the end of November, please do consider running a coffee morning after 9am, 11am or both Masses to raise funds for our Parish. Thank you.

Parish Centre: Those involved with the upkeep of the kitchen are concerned that people using the Centre are leaving opened packets of biscuits, cakes, milk, juice etc in the cupboards and the fridge. Please note if booking the Centre for a coffee morning, you must bring in fresh produce on the day and take anything left over with you when the event finishes. Please do not leave any items in the cupboards and the fridge for another day! Thank you.

Community Grocery – helping the people of Lincoln with their weekly shop! Did you know that anyone may join the Community Grocery initiative, through an annual membership of £5? After that it is only £4 per shop, with up to 5 shops per week (one shop per day, Monday-Friday 9.30am-4.30pm). The Community Grocery is in partnership with Acts Trust, Alive Church, and is located at the top of Beaumont Fee (Beaumont Manor), LN1 1UL.

Hospital Admission: Just a gentle reminder that if you, or a member of your family are admitted to hospital, the parish clergy are not automatically informed. If you wish to receive visits from a chaplain and/or receive any of the sacraments whilst in hospital, please let us know. Alternatively ask a member of the ward staff to contact the hospital chaplaincy team and they will arrange it. The chaplaincy team also hold the rota of priests available for administering the Sacrament of the Sick in emergencies at night.

The Diocese requires all volunteers with DBS clearance to undertake this training as part of their role within the parish. It can be done at a convenient time to suit the individual. Certificates of completion are available. Volunteers that do not require DBS clearance for their role do not have to complete the training but are encouraged and recommended to do so.
