Hospital Admission: Just a gentle reminder that if you, or a member of your family are admitted to hospital, the parish clergy are not automatically informed. If you wish to receive visits from a chaplain and/or receive any of the sacraments whilst in hospital, please let us know. Alternatively ask a member of the ward staff to contact the hospital chaplaincy team and they will arrange it. The chaplaincy team also hold the rota of priests available for administering the Sacrament of the Sick in emergencies at night.

Safeguarding Training: The CSSA (Catholic Safeguarding Standards Agency) is to shortly launch an online training portal which will allow all parish volunteers the opportunity to learn more about safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults and creating a safer environment for church activities. The Diocese requires all volunteers with DBS clearance to undertake this training as part of their role within the parish. It can be done at a convenient time to suit the individual. Certificates of completion are available. Volunteers that do not require DBS clearance for their role do not have to complete the training but are encouraged and recommended to do so.
