St Gilbert Pilgrimage Walk for the Homeless: Stuart Collingham has completed his 43 mile Walk from Sempringham to Lincoln Cathedral in three and a half days. He wishes to thank everyone who supported him, whether by organising the publicity and Just Giving site whist he was on holiday (thanks Jo), walking with him on the two most difficult stages, making a cash or online donation to Nomad or simply holding him in your prayers. When all the donations have been collected the target figure of £500 will have been exceeded by a significant margin. The final figure will be notified once everything has been collated and independently checked. Thank you.

Stations of the Nativity 2023: Last Christmas we successfully presented a live service of our "online Stations of the Nativity" at St Hugh's church with a mixture of readings, reflections, images and music. Society for the Protection of Unborn Children (SPUC) Campaign to End DIY Abortion: Since 2020 abortion providers have been sending women abortion pills through the post removing the requirement for an in-person consultation with a medical professional. A rise in 50% of ambulance callouts to these women and the recent case of Carla Foster who lied about her date of pregnancy and aborted her baby, Lily, at 32 weeks, well past the legal limit, demonstrate the dangers to women and the killing of viable near term babies.
