Second Collection for the Sick and Retired Priests' Fund to be taken at all Masses this weekend. The renovation of 2a Skellingthorpe Road is now complete, apart from some snagging issues that remain to be resolved. The works have obviously been at a cost. Whilst the sale of 240 Boultham Park Road realised a total of £244,050.00, the total cost of the project cost much more than that. The total for the complete reconfiguring, refurbishment purchase of certain items of furniture, and Professional Fees came to £530,060.29. This ate into our reserves and even with the sale of 240 Boultham Park Road we have been left with a debt to the Diocese £147,005.29. This debt will have to be paid off over the coming years through our Parish Income. Currently I am in negotiation with the Diocese as to how best we pay off this debt; i.e., how much per month and for how long. This situation gives me an opportunity to ask all who worship physically at SSPP or virtually via the Livestream to consider prayerfully and seriously their financial contribution. The best way any worshipper can help increase the income of the Parish is to consider Gift Aid and making your contribution via a Standing Order. If you are a **UK Taxpayer the Parish can claim back from the Government** £0.25 for every pound you give, which I know from experience if this was to be taken up by all who pay income tax this would greatly help the Parish and service our debt sooner rather than later. Forms are available at the back of the church whereby you can set up a Standing Order and also sign up for Gift Aid. Sincerely, Canon Geoffrey.
